

COMMISSAIRE'S COMMUNIQUE

1. Starters:

Team Managers will have the opportunity to forward modifications to the Secretary of the College of Commissaires. Any change, after the first confirmation, must be notified before 12:00 pm (noon) the day before each event. Any replacement rider for a confirmed selection may only be from the list of riders already registered.

2. Team Relay:

The start order of the members of the team relay have to be given to the secretary of the commissaires panel before the completion of the medal presentations on the 28th May 2023.

The team relay meeting will take place on Monday, 29th May 2023, at 13.00 at the Team relay zone.

3. Equipment:

As per UCI Regulation 16.14.001, all bicycles used in the competition must be in conformity with UCI regulations. A pre check of bikes will be offered on Friday, May 26th from 13.00 to 14.00 and at least 1 hour before the start of the ITTs each day.

Riders must show for the bike check at least 15 minutes prior their official start.

Reminder: The start will be refused if the bicycle or the equipment is not in conformity with the regulations.

Safety bars must remain fitted throughout the event (TT and RR).

In all cases the riders must take the start in the uniform as approved at the licence control.

4. Helmets colours for the road races:

Article 16.10.002 indicates the required colours for each class. Riders using the wrong helmet colour in the mass start races will not be allowed to start and/or will be withdrawn from the race and disqualified.

5. Numbers:

Numbers must be displayed as prominently as possible, at the left side.

Time Trial: Only one number is required, in the lower back, in the centre, this number may be in a see through pocket. Frame numbers are not required.

For the hand bikes: two number stickers one each side – along with the frame number mounted on the safety bar.

Road Race: Two body numbers to be fixed left and right to be fixed outside clothing not in see through pockets. The frame number is also required.

For the hand bikes: two stickers are required left and right on the hand bike, one bib number on the left leg and a number frame number on the safety bar like as below and from regulation article 16.17.016.



For the Team Relay: New number stickers will be issued. Please fix these small numbers in a visible position on left side of the handbike.



6. Call up order for the road races:

According to UCI Rules, riders will be called up before the start of each event.

All riders must present themselves 200 meters before the start line (100 meters behind the first group for the next group) no later than 10 minutes before their start time for the call up and form the “fish bone” formation. Riders are reminded to sign on prior to call up. Any riders not present when called up must fall in at the rear of their race bunch.

7. Drafting:

Drafting in road race is only permitted amongst riders of the same starting group (bib color), any rider taking pace or drafting from a rider of a different group will be disqualified.

8. Safe position on the bike (C,B,T)

Riders must observe the standard position as defined by article 1.3.008. Sitting on the bicycle’s top tube is prohibited. Furthermore, using the forearms as a point of support on the handlebar is prohibited except in time trials.

9. Hand bike Disk Wheels.

As per 16.17.008, disk wheels are permitted for all competitions. However, for categories H1 to H4, rear disk wheels must be no more than ETRTO 406mm to ensure riders visibility.

10. Feeding:

Feeding is permitted only in the designated areas on each lap, except on the first and final lap.

Feeding is authorized from both sides of the road. Feeding is not permitted during the time trial and team relay events.

There will be one Green Zone after the Feeding Zone – and all waste must be deposited in this zone. Disposing of waste outside the Green Zone will result in penalties being applied.

11. Technical Zones:

Time trial and road races: There will be 3 technical zones. Refer to the course maps.

12. Ranking of Road Races

Any riders overtaken by the leader of their race shall continue competing. When the race leader finishes his last lap, all other riders shall end their race when they next cross the finish line as per article 16.7.007

13. Ceremonies

The wearing of headbands, sunglasses, gloves and caps is not allowed at the podium ceremonies. If face masks are worn, no advertising is allowed.
