

## Communiqué from Technical Delegate

### Technical Service on Sat May, 7<sup>th</sup>

As discussed in the team managers meeting on May 6th, neutral service on Saturday, May 7th service will be done by maximum four volunteers countries during the competition.

Additionally: To give the teams the opportunity to service riders suffering a mechanical problem, it was decided that technical assistance is possible at any appropriate and safe place on the circuit. Helpers have to wear team clothing. Feeding will remain permitted only in the feeding zones.

### Team Convoys for Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> May

As communicated in the team managers meeting today, a limited number of team cars will be permitted to follow during the races on Sunday. It is recommended that each permitted nation partner with a second nation not in the convoy allow for the maximum number of opportunities for athletes support.
