1. Official communiqués

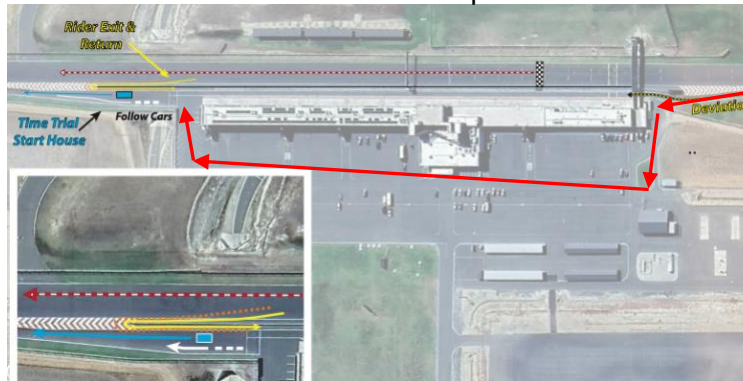

2. Training

Regular training is recommended according to the local traffic rules; Handbike Athletes must put a flag on their handbike.

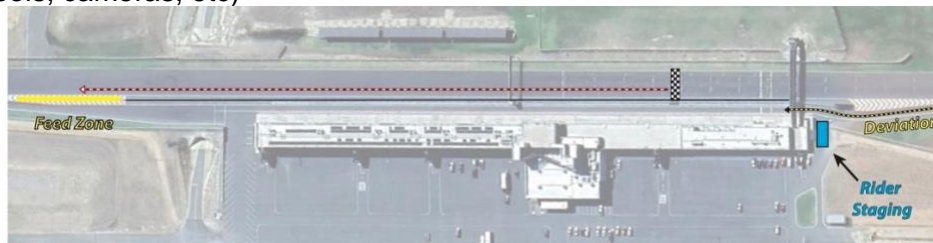
3. Time Trial

Race course is closed, so training on the course is forbidden
Team following cars are allowed; at the deviation, cars must exit to the external parking and re-enter by the gate at the other side of the building to follow the next rider
After the finish line, Athletes must exit the course after the pit lane



4. Road Races

Race course is closed so training on the course is forbidden
Feed/waste zone is located just after the pit lane with signs.
Call up will be run with the "fish-bone" format, please let the Riders take position as it needed
At the start of C1-C2-C3 races, to prevent possible accidents, rider holders **can't wear/hold** any item (backpack, wheels, cameras, etc)



5. Doping Control

Doping Control area is located in one of the garages, with specific signals.

For specific and more accurate instructions please look at the information provided by the Doping Control Officer.

6. Protocol

We remind that the Protocol Ceremony is a relevant part of the event, so please Team Managers are strongly required to pay attention to take the Athletes to the Ceremony on time
