2. Training


- It is strongly recommended to follow traffic rules during training and circulation with open traffic; Handbike Athletes **must** put a flag on their handbike and people accompanying Athletes **must** wear a helmet !!
- On Race days, traffic will be open during lunch break, so official training is not allowed and riders must respect the traffic rules.

3. Course


Due to some floods during past days, it wasn't possible to repair some portions of the original roads and so an adjustment of the course is necessary.

The new course is as on the map and here is the link to download the gpx file



4. Time Trial


- Race course will be closed (vehicles and cyclists) 60' before the start; after this time, traffic on the course is forbidden
- Training on the race course is not allowed after the start of the first rider
- Riders must come to the bike check, located near the start area, 15 minutes before their start.
- After the finish line, Athletes must exit the course, following the instruction by the volunteers
- Following cars **are allowed**; please refer to the map and the signalisation to reach the entry point.
- Team cars deviation is located at the last bend before the finish line. Follow the signalisation to reach the Team Area or the entry point



4. Road Races



- Race direction will be the opposite of TT
- Race course will be closed (vehicles) 60' before the start; after this time, traffic on the course is forbidden.
- Training on the race course is not allowed after the start of the first race.
- Athletes are requested to reach the start line from the road aside the University. **Please do not take the finish straight in the opposite direction**
- At the call up, Athletes are required to adopt the **"Fish-Bone system"**
- At the start of C1-C2-C3 races, to prevent possible accidents, rider **holders can't wear/hold** any item (backpack, wheels, etc)

5. Team Relay

- Each participating Team in the Team Relay must present their start list to the Commissaires Secretary **at the Confirmation of Starters**; Team Relay meeting will be conducted just after the Team Managers Meeting.

6. Protocol

- We remind that the Protocol Ceremony is a **relevant part** of the event, so please Team Managers are strongly required to pay attention to take the Athletes to the Ceremony **on time**.
